Essential requirements

- » A completed application
- » Your resume/CV
- » One 500-word essay per scholarship
- » Other requirements vary by scholarship

Additional requirements

- » Merit-based
- » Minimum GPA of 3.0 and good academic standing
- » Submit a short written statement (no more than one page) explaining how their academic and/or extracurricular pursuits will help to continue the 70+ years of public service legacy of Governor L. Douglas Wilder
- » Full-time undergraduate students enrolled in any degree program in the Wilder School as their primary major (preference given to newly admitted students)
- » Full-time graduate students enrolled in a Wilder School master's degree program who earned an undergraduate degree from Virginia Union University or Howard University

The National Ovation to L. Douglas Wilder **Scholarships**

The National Ovation to L. Douglas Wilder is an opportunity to help launch a new generation of public servants. Scholarships are provided for **VCU undergraduate students** who have as their primary major a degree program in the L. Douglas Wilder School of Government and Public Affairs.

Scholarships are also available to **individuals enrolled for their master's degree** at the Wilder School and earned their undergraduate degree from **Virginia Union University or Howard University**.
